WAR DIARY OF THE HASTINGS COMMAND.

During the month, the Rt. Hon. Sir Robert Borden visited Hastings and, at a cerumonial Parade held in Marrior Square, presented mediate to R.C.O's and men. He safterwards conducted an imposition of this Area, visiting several Messes and other Units in this Commend.

During the month, the End.Cansdian Command Depot, Lieut.Colonel H.S. Tobin, in charge, was transferred from Emotings to Bramshott, and in talk transfer 35 Officers and 1470 Other Hanks were despatched.

The 3rd.Canadian Command Depot, Lieut.Colonel W.F. Konp, in charge, was transferred from Heatings to Sectord, 50 Officers and 223 Other Ranks being despatched.

The average strength of the Hastings Command throughout the month of July was 486 Officers 4573 Other Runks.

Hight operations were carried out at the Canadian Trench Warfare Schhol, at Dewhill under Active Service conditions which were quite satisfactory.

On orders from London, Air Raid Action was taken July 7th. 14th. and 22nd.

The Heatings Fior was totally destroyed by fire on the afternoon of Sunlay, July 15th.
